The Fort Valley Utility Commission will furnish all materials for this project, so please consider this as a request for a labor only bid. Time of completion for all work associated with this project shall be ninety (90) consecutive calendar days from the date written on the Notice to Proceed.

Bids will be considered only from experienced and LICENSED contractor(s) engaged in work of this type and magnitude.

**Bids will be received at the Fort Valley Utility Commission Administrative Office, 500 Anthoine St, Fort Valley Georgia, 31030 until 10:00 am on Thursday, March 18, 2021.** All bid envelopes should be sealed and clearly marked **“Sealed Bid for Express Circuit for Peach County High School”**. No bid may be altered, withdrawn, or resubmitted after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

**A mandatory prebid meeting is scheduled for Thursday March 4, 2021 at 1:00pm** at Fort Valley Utility Commission meeting room located at 500 Anthoine St, Fort Valley Georgia, 31030. There will be a bid opening in the Fort Valley Utility Commission Meeting Room located at 500 Anthoine St, Fort Valley Georgia, 31030 at **10:00 am on March 18, 2021**. The Fort Valley Utility Commission reserves the right to reject any and all bids in total, or in part, and/or waive defects in bids.

Upon successful bid notification, the contractor will be asked to provide proof of insurance and evidence of a 5% bond.

Prior to execution of a contract, a Contract Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, each equal to 100% of the contract amount, per section, must be provided by the successful bidder by a surety company qualified to do business in the State of Georgia and satisfactory to the Fort Valley Utility Commission.
