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ADDENDUM NO. 1 REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR FORT VALLEY WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT EFFLUENT PIPE CONSTRUCTION

This Addendum modifies and supplements the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Fort Valley Wastewater Treatment Plant Effluent Pipe Construction issued by the Fort Valley Utility Commission (Owner). All other terms and conditions of the RFP not expressly modified herein remain in full force and effect. Proposers are required to acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in their submitted proposal using revised Volume 3 – Procurement Proposal Form, included herein.

ITEM 1- REVISED PROPOSAL SUBMITTAL DATE

The request for proposal time frame has been extended by 2 weeks. The new proposal submittal date is now Friday, July 24th, 2026, at 2:00 PM. All other details concerning submittal of proposals will remain the same as previously published.

ITEM 2- REVISED SCOPE OF WORK: TRANSFER PIPELINE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION ADDITION

SCOPE ADDITION: The scope of work is revised to add the design and construction of **15,000 linear feet (LF) of 12-inch PVC transfer pipe (Force Main)**. Pipe material shall be either **Fusible PVC** or **C900 PVC Pressure Pipe (DR 18)** at the Proposer's discretion and as supported by the Proposer's design approach. Both pipe types are considered acceptable for all project scopes. Proposers shall clearly identify the pipe material selected in their technical proposal and provide justification for the selection based on constructability, hydraulics, and project conditions.

See **Exhibit A in this addendum— Project Location Map** (attached) for the approximate alignment of the new transfer pipe.

ITEM 3- REVISED ENTITY RESPONSIBILITY REQUIREMENT

DELETED: Any requirement in the RFP Advertisement, Proposal Requirements, or Proposal Information Sheet specifying that a single entity must hold sole or single-point responsibility for both the design and construction of the project is hereby deleted.

SUBSTITUTED: Proposals may be submitted by **a single firm or by a team comprised of more than one entity**. Where a team approach is proposed, the proposal shall clearly identify a **Prime Proposer** who will serve as the single point of contact with the Owner and will be the signatory to any resulting contract. Subcontractors, subconsultants, or teaming partners performing design, construction, or specialty work shall be identified in the proposal, along with their respective roles and qualifications. The Prime Proposer

shall bear ultimate contractual responsibility to the Owner for all work performed under the contract, regardless of the number of entities involved.

ITEM 4 — REVISED CONTRACTOR LICENSE REQUIREMENT

DELETED: Any reference in the RFP Advertisement, Proposal Requirements, or Proposal Information Sheet to a "State Contractor License" or "General Contractor License" as a prerequisite for eligibility or award is hereby changed.

SUBSTITUTED: The construction entity responsible for installation of the effluent pipe and related work shall hold a valid **State of Georgia Utility Contractor License** issued by the State Licensing Board for Residential and General Contractors (or its applicable division) in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 43-41 et seq. The license shall be in good standing at the time of proposal submission and shall remain in good standing throughout the duration of the project. Proposers shall include a copy of the applicable license(s) or documentation of licensure eligibility with their proposal. Provide Utility Contractor License number where contractor's number is requested.

ITEM 5 – REVISED AND REISSUED PROPOSAL FORMS

DELETED: All Price Proposal Forms previously issued with the Proposal Package are hereby withdrawn and superseded in their entirety.

SUBSTITUTED: The revised **Price Proposal Forms PP-1 through PP-15** are reissued with this Addendum and are attached hereto. The revised forms reflect the updated project scope and space to reference Addenda.

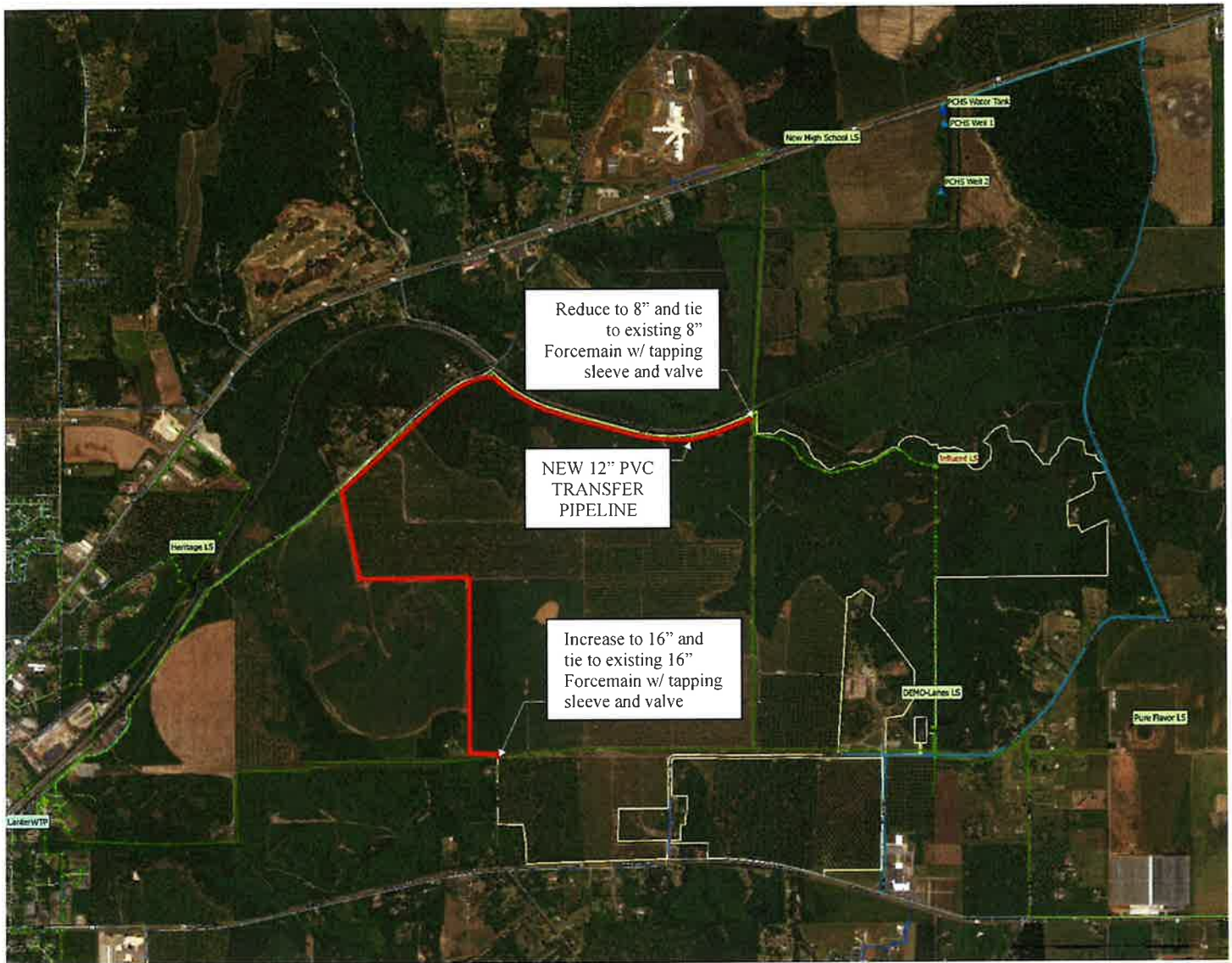
